Wednesday 30 November –

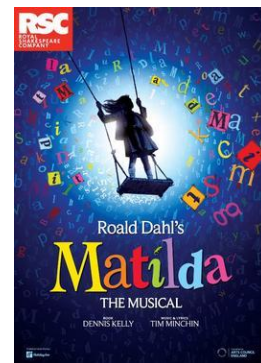

Wednesday 7 December –

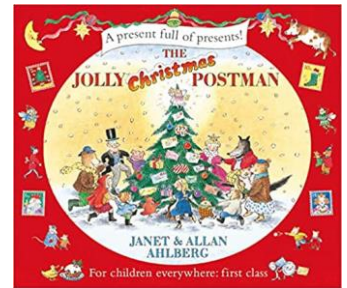
